
ORDER

This day came Nelson Fisher, Commonwealth Attorney, Timothy V. Anderson, Attorney for the Defendant and Jeffery Keith Winston, the Defendant.

The Commonwealth for good cause shown moved the Court for a nolle prosequi to the charges of (1) Attempted Capital Murder §18.2-31; 18.2-10 (2) Abduction §18.2-47; 18.2-10 (3) Forcible Sodomy §18.2-67.1 and (4) Aggravated Sexual Battery §18.2-67.3.A.2 and (5) Attempted Rape §18.2-61 and 18.2-26 because the victim did not appear in Court on the day of trial. The Court having been satisfied that due diligence had been made on the part of the Office of the Commonwealth Attorney to have the victim present, and that the same constituted good cause, over the objection by the Defense, granted the motion to nolle prosequi.

Accordingly, a nolle prosequi is ordered in this matter.
